From the season we are now in to the verb used quite often, the word "fall" is very ingrained in our culture today. The Bible and commentary around it are no different. While not mentioned specifically, we tend to refer to Genesis chapter 3 as "The Fall" indicating the incident of sin and its consequences that went forth.

Another usage I hear a lot, sadly, is someone who has, "fallen away" or an individual who has stopped coming to church and is living in sin. Matthew 13:20-21 says, "As for what was sown on rocky ground, this is the one who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy, yet he has no root in himself, but endures for a while, and when tribulation or persecution arises on account of the word, immediately he falls away."

Matthew 26:33 says, "Peter answered him, "Though they all fall away because of you, I will never fall away." 1 Timothy 3:6 says, "He must not be a recent convert, or he may become puffed up with conceit and fall into the condemnation of the devil." Falling generally seems to be a negative thing: you hear so and so fell and got hurt, but that is not always the case in the Bible!

Luke 8:41-42 says, "And there came a man named Jairus, who was a ruler of the synagogue. And falling at Jesus' feet, he implored him to come to his house, for he had an only daughter, about twelve years of age, and she was dying." When we talk about falling away and the scriptures mentioned before, the direction of that action is away from the Lord. Jarius falls at Christ's feet and does so because he knows Christ alone can help.

As we look to the season changing, let us fall at Jesus's feet. He is due much honor, praise, and adoration. He provides what no one else can. We shouldn't seek him out only in instances of crisis, though such prayers are needed, but ALWAYS. For those who have fallen away, pray, reach out, plead for all to live at His feet.
