Hide 'n' Seek

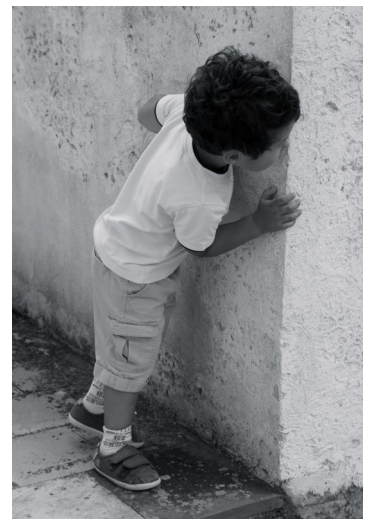

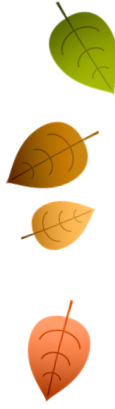
