Daylight Has Been Saved!

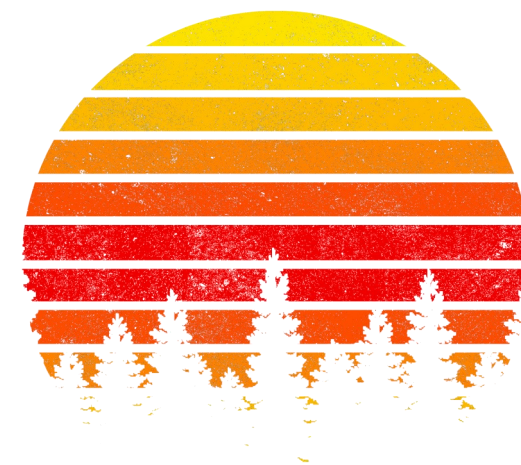

This bill is not the first one to address the daylight savings issues as it has gone back and forth over the years. From 1918 with the first Act that was signed all the way until the 60's Americans were dealing with the back and forth of this matter.

The original sponsors highlighted the possible benefits for it. All the while there were those against it who cited the negative sides to it. To me it is quite interesting to see, not just in our own country, but around the world how people deal with time. On a day which we have "fallen back an hour" I feel it is appropriate to think of spiritual similarities.

One thing we can focus on is how we use our time. Our own sleeping patterns and schedules may be thrown off for a little while as we go through the time change. I hope regardless of time changes and levels of fatigue we make God a priority.

Another thing I think of is the phrase "saving daylight". We serve the one who made day and night and who is the source of salvation and thus the originator of saving. Psalm 27:1-2 says, "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?" When the sun rises and sets, may it remind us of the security that comes with the salvation offered through Christ, the light of the world and provider of life.
