# ylight Has Been Saved!

Psalm 27:1-2 says, "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?" When the sun rises and sets, may it remind us of the security that comes with the salvation offered through Christ, the light of the world and provider of life.
