Storm Shelter

For many of us storms have been and continue to be a source of fear, anxiety, and concern. Even lately, we continue to pray and help those impacted by the severe weather in Kentucky. My first recollection of tornadoes is from the movie *The Wizard of Oz*, a moment that almost 100 years later is still scary to think about happening to you with windows breaking and what not. As of late I’ve thought a lot more about severe storms with my brother living close to higher risk areas of tornadoes as well the storms we have been dealing with in the area.

With that in mind, I think about a storm shelter or at least a safe place to go to in times of storms. Psalm 5:11-12 says “But let all who take refuge in you rejoice; let them ever sing for joy, and spread your protection over them, that those who love your name may exult in you. For you bless the righteous, O Lord; you cover him with favor as with a shield.”

Psalm 18:1-3 says, “I love you, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. I call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies.”

If we get an alert to seek shelter we follow it and our spiritual storms ought to be no different. Like David’s words in the Psalms we need to prioritize taking refuge in the Lord. Do we really believe He is our rock and our strength? Our shield and stronghold. Who do we call upon in times of need and times of rejoicing? He is our shelter from the storms. Nothing can overpower Him and we alone choose whether we seek out His unwavering protection. So in times of severe storms with strong gusts of wind that can knock us down and damage so much, seek shelter.
