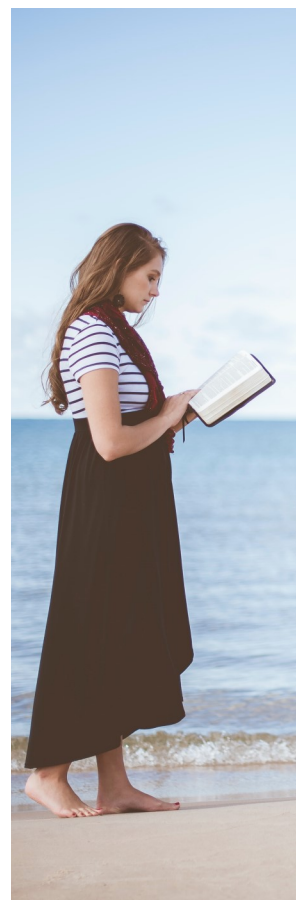
Summer Fun, Here We Come!
