Whether it be observing the beauty of the midday, summer skies or being in awe of the night sky and its wonders, they certainly help me remember my place in this world. While letting everything sink in and appreciating creation I could not help but go looking for passages about both matters. In that search I found Psalm 147:2-6 “The Lord builds up Jerusalem; he gathers the outcasts of Israel. He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds. He determines the number of the stars; he gives to all of them their names. Great is our Lord, and abundant in power; his understanding is beyond measure. The Lord lifts up the humble; he casts the wicked to the ground.”

Jerusalem was the chosen city for the Lord’s temple for many years and still is a very sacred place to gather. I think it’s important for us to never forget He is not just a healer but the best healer and mender of our wounds. I find it so interesting then in the midst of talking about the Lord’s ability as healer to the needy that the Psalmist takes time to glorify and praise Him. This praise is written in a few parts.

While knowledge of the Lord and His Word varies, we are still able to gaze upon the innumerable stars above us in the skies. He determined the number of them and even named them! How about that for excellence and greatness?

The Psalmist then says “Great is our Lord.” What a fundamental truth that is! Human greatness pales in comparison to Him! He is as the text also says, abundant in power and his understanding is beyond measure. Not only did He design all of creation, and thus understands it, He understands you and me. It is then that the reminder of how the Lord treats the wicked and more importantly the humble.

Certainly, He is the one we need to turn to when we are broken, when we are overcome with wounds. Certainly, He is the one so deserving of our praise given who He is and what He has done. So as we enjoy the nice summer days and continue to work through our trials, both personally and as a congregation, I implore you to take a note or two from the words of the Psalmist in the 147th Psalm. ☆

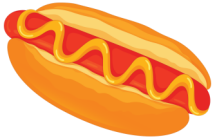
