Whether it was a back-to-school backpack drive where I worked in St. Louis, the back-to-school bash we had where I attended kindergarten through

eighth grade, or the "Welcome Home" at Freed, there was always some excitement (and probably a lot of dread by students and teachers alike). I know many who were relieved upon graduation from high school to not have to go to class anymore, others were looking forward to more schooling.

I understand not everyone enjoys the rigors of school or the teaching style of many classrooms, but it cannot be denied that the follower of God is a lifelong student.
