Humility



Humility is often talked about in religious circles but it has its place in secular culture as well. You think of Christ's example or the words of his brother "Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will exalt you" (Js 4:10). In a secular context, humility can be brought up in the workplace, or where I usually see it the most, in sports/famous people. I understand confidence in that line of work but there is a lot of arrogance running around. Yet, as you might be thinking, arrogance and pride are not exclusive to the famous.

You can probably come up with a few people that fit the bill. I had an experience visiting a church that really humbled me. A man was confused about the absence of the King James Version and the use of unknown translations. At first, I thought the man was just giving the class teacher a hard time because he was reading from the New International Version because it has had a not so good reputation among some (If you want to talk about translation questions my door is always open). The conversation continued to go back and forth throughout the class.

I learned, only after church, that this man had put on Christ in baptism a year prior and had no exposure to other translations or religious publications. He is in his 60's or 70's. We can all take away a few things from this: 1. People may know less than you think. 2. People may know more than you think. 3. You can do more than you think.

I was glad the man was wanting to learn but felt for him in his confusion. At least he wasn't afraid to ask! How are we to know where someone else OR ourselves are at if we don't ask? You know enough to talk to others about God. Do not be afraid of questions, after all the best questions leave us humbled.
