Our King



As we conclude another November election time, I sit and reflect on what we face as Kentuckians and Americans as well as what our brothers and sisters in Christ all over the globe face. There are two passages I always go back to, when thinking about government and politics.

“Let every person be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and those that exist have been instituted by God. 2 Therefore whoever resists the authorities resists what God has appointed, and those who resist will incur judgment” (Rom. 13:1-2).

“18 For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. 19 Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things. 20 But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself” (Philip. 3:18-21).

No matter who is in power, our final citizenship is in heaven because Christ is King. What I want to leave you with is a few thoughts I’ve had this week in my reflection. How many people chose not to vote? How many voted but did not research the candidates and only cared about a some designation?
