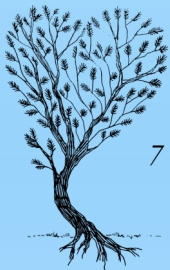

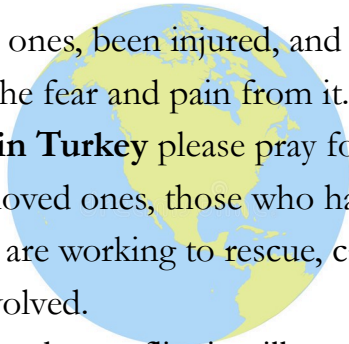
- **Health:** Ann Zeitz, Raymond Sullivan, & Louis Massey
