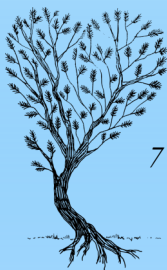

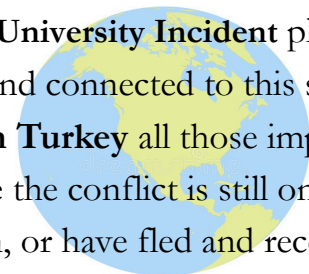
- **Health:** Ann Zeitz, Faye Welter, & Louis Massey

Continued From Front → Matthew 14:13a says, "Now when Jesus heard this, he withdrew from there in a boat to a desolate place by himself."
