### *God's Light*

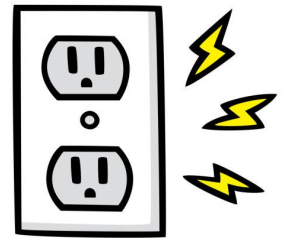
Lord, you are the light

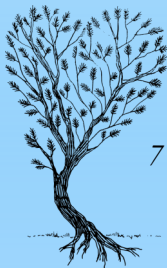
