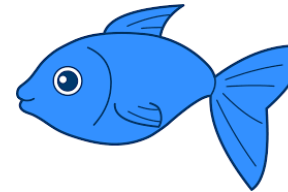

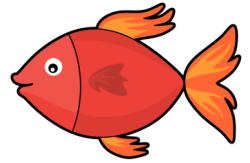

SOMETHING FISHY



From the desk of Ben Rominske, minister

As Dr. Seuss once said “Red fish, blue fish. One fish two fish.” This past week, we took a bus trip to Jim’s Seafood in Frankfurt. I know many people either love seafood (and sushi) or really don’t like it as well as some of us who like a few things but not all. Maybe a lake and rod are what you think of when you hear the word fish or the smell of a nice cooked fillet. Why not think about the Bible?

Fish are mentioned throughout the Bible but play quite a prominent role in the gospels as multiple apostles are fishermen. It is due to their occupation that we get the famous quote, “And he said to them, ‘Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.’” (Matt. 4:19). From that scripture there is also a wonderful evangelism ministry of the same name.

Fish were also central to various miracles Jesus performed, namely the feeding of the five and four thousand. In John 21, Jesus miraculously caused 153 fish to fill the nets of the disciples. 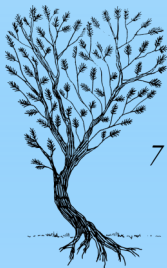
