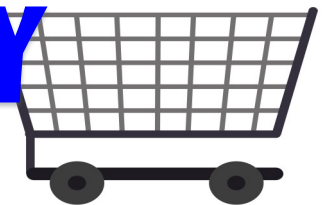

THE SHOPPING CART THEORY

The anonymous poster of this theory said, "The shopping cart is the ultimate litmus test for whether a person is capable of self-governing." The idea behind this theory is based on relatively low effort involved in returning your shopping cart to the proper spot. We have all seen carts left in parking spots, wedged on a curb, and so on.

Are you really in that much of a hurry to not help keep the parking lot in order and allow for ease of maintenance by workers? I've seen and heard of carts being left behind that blow in the wind striking cars or pulling into a spot that has a cart and you hit it. Something that is such a small task can end up having a much larger impact.

I don't think there is necessarily a one to one comparison for a Christian but I can think of a handful of things that are similar to this thought process. 1. Stand up for your faith. We have nothing to be ashamed of (Rom. 1:16) 2. Openly talk about your faith. Maybe it comes up when you talk about plans with people, maybe it comes up at the bank and you're getting new checks which you mainly use for giving. 3. Show up. Assemble with your brothers and sisters in Christ. Come to activity nights, fellowship meals, and more.

You never know how much good the smallest things can do. On the other hand, imagine what harm can be done when we don't do these things and instead stay silent, neglecting our responsibilities as Christians.
