

Egg-citement

From the desk of Ben Rominske, minister

It is not the time for giving in the sense of

Christmas. Instead, it is the time for eggs, made of chocolate and full of candy (sometimes money too! Those were my favorite growing up). Yet, aside from the fun of hunting for eggs, this is one time we see a great surge of people in church. I will not speculate here as to why that might be the case, but I do believe it is important to remember for those who assemble regularly.

I do not know the number of people who will be celebrating Easter but I cannot imagine it is less than 1 billion. 1,000,000,000 for reference. That's a lot of zeros! Easter celebrates Christ's resurrection. In 1 Corinthians 11, and Acts 20 we see references to the meal instituted by Christ that was practiced by all churches. Paul will specifically say that every time we partake of it we remember his death until he returns (1 Cor. 11:26).

The remembrance of his death while connected to Christ's resurrections is still a separate part, though we often view it all together. In 1 Corinthians 15 Paul discusses the resurrection at length. One way we see in scripture to emulate the death, burial, and resurrection is through baptism (Rom. 6:1-11). Baptism is also tied to the resurrection in 1 Peter 1:3, as well as 1 Peter 3:21 "Baptism, which corresponds to this, now saves you, not as a removal of dirt from the body but as an appeal to God for a good conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ"
