Growing up I played tee-ball and then baseball once I got older. I wasn't the best hitter nor was I that good at playing second base. I happened though, to enjoy catcher the most. This combined with my general support for Detroit teams had me cheering for our catcher who was very good at the time. I even got the opportunity to go to a game. I still remember the score and the team.

I know not everyone enjoys baseball, but it holds a special place in my heart. I think of the three main things one needs to play baseball: a glove/mitt, a bat, and a ball. Most of us know you only use a bat on offense and a glove/mitt on defense. The ball on the other hand is used by both teams at certain times. I say all of this to set up some thoughts for us.

A batter, especially at the pro level, has such a small time to react to the pitch coming at them. The pitcher will try to make pitches look like other things in order to trick a batter. Similarly, we must be on guard. We must be ready to react quickly and wary of what is coming our way (1 Pet. 5:8).
