The Greatest Day

From the desk of Ben Rominske, minister

All credit for this idea goes to PTP and Joshua Cantrell, minister and brother in Christ, for coming up with and presenting this idea. What would you define as the three greatest days of your life? Maybe you would say when you got married, became a parent/grandparent, and decided to follow Christ. In his lesson, Joshua presented three biblically based answers for this question as each one builds upon the former.

#1 The day we first heard the gospel. I personally had not thought about this as one of them but it makes a lot of sense. We love to quote Romans 10:13-14;17, "13 For "everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."14 How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? 17 So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."

#2 The day we chose to be baptized. Paul makes reference to this in Romans as he refers to being saved first but back tracks to talk about the need for hearing. What then about this phrase "calling on the name"? Acts 22:16 says, "And now why do you wait? Rise and be baptized and wash away your sins, calling on his name.' The "he" here is referring to our Lord as there are many references to him in the section as well.

#3 Going "Home". Paul will talk about how our citizenship is in heaven and that to die is gain. For the Christian this is the culmination of not just the prior mentioned days but also of a life of faithfulness. I think Christ says it best in John 14:2-3 "2 In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, that where I am you may be also. "
